Requirements vary by state, but:

- you need to be a U.S. citizen,
- A resident of the community where you're registering,
- and be at least 18 years old by Election Day.

You have several ways to register:

- sign up in-person at your local election office or other government agency,
- send your registration form in the mail,
- and many states allow voters to register online.
