The Secretary of State intends to provide grants to county officials for the purpose of updating equipment used on and before election day and providing necessary security improvements. The Secretary of State intends to make these funds available to those counties who have met minimum security best practices, in an effort to incentivize the adoption of recommended cyber hygiene, cybersecurity, and physical security best practices. This grant funds would be available under the same formula as the county grant funds distributed from the 2020 HAVA grant. Eligible voting equipment would include electronic poll books and necessary support equipment, tabulators, central count equipment, ballot drop boxes and equipment necessary to secure ballot drop boxes, and polling place equipment facilitating accessibility including but not limited to accessible voting devices.
